

## PRIOR TO THE SHOW WEEKEND

- 1 Tickets are on sale from Monday 21 May 2018.
- 2 Rehearsal times will be allocated for each category and will be held during the weekend of Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 June 2018. This information will be forwarded to you once all entries are received and collated.
- 3 There will be a full show rehearsal (no costumes) on Thursday 14 June 2018 during the afternoon at a time to be advised.
- 4 **It is important to attend these rehearsals.**
- 5 Once your entry has been received, no name change, change of descriptions or change of music can be made.
- 6 Costumes must be able to move freely onto the stage and models must have 100% clear vision. No dressing will be allowed on stage and no costumes can be stored on the stage.
- 7 Judging will take place on Friday night and Saturday (times to be advised).
- 8 We would appreciate your costume for the Sunday 17 June display.
- 9 Your safety and that of your model is your responsibility. For example, alcohol consumption should be kept to a minimum.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1 \$20 per entry. One entry per form (please attach entry fee). No Refunds.
- 2 **Entries close 5pm Monday 21 May 2018.** No late entries will be accepted. Right of entry is reserved. Send entry to:  
**The Recycled Trash Fashion Show, PO Box 83, Kaikoura 7340.**
- 3 Music must be provided by the contestant on a memory stick with the entry form.
- 4 All entries are to be made from recycled material as recycled content will be the major part of the judging. Earthquake Opportunity greaseproof paper is available free of charge.
- 5 A sewing machine can be used in all categories. String, tape, wire, velcro, staples, glue or any other medium can be used to build your garment.
- 6 All garments must be original and have not been entered in any previous competition.
- 7 Kids’ Art made by children 12 years and under as at Friday 15 June 2018.
- 8 Teens Art to be made by persons 13 – 19 years as at Friday 15 June 2018.
- 9 **A declaration must be signed by a parent/caregiver/teacher** to say the work was made by the child in Category A or was made by a collaborative group in Category B. Judges will take particular note of the standard and the age of the child.
- 10 **Young Designer aged 13 to 19 years:** to qualify, please tick the box on the entry form.
- 11 Models can be male or female of any age (apart from the Evening category where models must be over 16. No animals are allowed. No more than two models per entry are allowed.
- 12 Models can model one costume only. However, special permission to model more costumes may be granted.
- 13 No more than two designers per entry are allowed in dressing room.
- 14 All models must have clear vision.
- 15 Garments are to be left in the hall after the Friday night show and repairs are to be done in the hall. **No alterations to designs are allowed.**
- 16 All judges’ decisions are final.
- 17 Any garments or photographs may be used for future publicity.
- 18 The major sponsor may wish to display your entry.
